

Fees Policy

- a) Annual fees are due in full on or before the first game of the schedule. A player who does not pay in full on or before their first game shall be deemed to have withdrawn from membership in the League. The Division Convenor, upon request, may reinstate the member in default, who shall pay a late fee of \$25 in addition to the full annual fee.
- b) Players wishing to maintain their membership in the League and intending to join play later in the season may do so by paying fees in full, as stated above, and indicating estimated date of return.
- c) All Players who join during the season shall pay a prorated fee, based on the number of games remaining in the season, plus an administrative fee of \$25.00.
- d) Refunds may be paid on compassionate grounds for a member who withdraws from playing in the league missing at least two months of consecutive game days due to injury, illness or family obligations. Players must declare their intent to withdraw as soon as possible.
 - No refunds shall be given for a member who leaves within 2 months of the end of the season
 - All refunds shall be reduced by an administrative fee of \$25
 - No refunds will be considered for work or vacation reasons
 - Pro-rated refund of dues shall be disbursed at season's end
 - A player must apply for a refund in writing to the Convenor of their division, before the end of February and include:
 - The reason for withdrawal
 - A self-addressed stamped envelope
 - Any refund shall be determined by the Convenor based on the number of games remaining in the season
 - The Board reserves the right to suspend the payment of refunds at any time.
- e) London Senior Hockey will accept payments in the form of cheque, e-transfer, bank draft or postal money order. No cash payments or credit card payments will be accepted.

E-transfers

We continue to accept cheques for payments to London Senior Hockey, however you can now pay your hockey fees (and golf fees) to London Senior Hockey on line, by way of e-Transfers as follows:

- 1. Sign onto your own bank account web page and go to Interac e-Transfers.**
- 2. Enter London Senior Hockey as a new Contact for you to send money to.**
- 3. Select email as the method to notify the league about your payment.**
- 4. Enter the following email address so that we know about your payment:**

- 5. Enter your division and team # in the message section.**
- 6. London Senior Hockey does not require a security question in order to accept e-Transfers.**
- 7. For payments of Hockey fees, please provide your captain with a copy of the e-Transfer email that you receive to show that your fees have been paid.**
