UPDATE ON COVID-19 SITUATION

I have been in weekly contact with WFD regarding any new developments for the upcoming season. As it stands right now, they are developing a four-phase protocol to allow them to hopefully open up for hockey in the fall.

Part of this protocol is the need to clear out all storage areas. The period set up by WFD with LSH cooperation, would be between the hours of 10 and 11 am, and 1 and 2 pm. This would occur on Wednesday July 15 and Thursday July 16.

In order to maintain some sort of order, we should abide by the following schedule.

Junior division	Wednesday, July 15	10:00 am to 11:00 am
Int. division	Wednesday, July 15	1:00 pm to 2:00 pm
Senior division	Thursday, July 16	10:00 am to 11:00 am
Stragglers	Thursday, July 16	1:00 pm to 2:00 pm

We will be allowed to enter at the Tony's entrance (lower side door). They will be restricting entrance to allow only 5 users every 15 minutes. We must follow the directional signage to enter and exit the facility. Please empty your locker quickly then depart. No lingering or chatting in the halls.

While exiting, WFD is asking that keys be returned and a current address be provided so they are able to mail you a cheque for your refund. WFD will have a staff member situated in the Tony's entrance and this is where you will return your keys, not up at Guest Services. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated, and anything we can do to help get us back on the ice is always a plus.

On that note, if and when we get back to league play, our hockey may be very different from the past depending on new health and safety rules dictated by the various authorities. At this time, no one knows what these may entail, but rest assured, we will have some adapting to do.

If you have any concerns regarding returning to play in any form, please express this to your team captain from last season (2019/20). If you stay and chat with your fellow members outside, again, please remember your mask and social distancing. Let's try and keep us all healthy.
